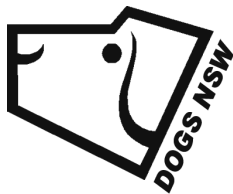

UTILITY & UTILITY EXCELLENT AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

Only one medallion per class, the highest, will be awarded to any dog. Qualifying passes for these awards must be gained on or before Wednesday 20 September 2017. Exhibitors who are eligible for these awards **must** notify the Trial Secretary at euraidd@bigpond.net.au or 0410 583 186 by Wednesday **20 September 2017**, otherwise award cannot be presented.

PERPETUAL AWARDS - For the purpose of these awards (except for the Beale Stitt Memorial Award) trials must be between Saturday 1 October 2016 and Friday 29 September 2017 inclusive.

All applications for Perpetual Awards **MUST** be lodged with the Scorer (or nominee) Ms J Kaldor no later than 1.00 pm on Saturday 30 September 2017.

BEALE STITT MEMORIAL AWARD - For the winner of the run-off between Novice RATG winner & Open RATG winner at the NSW Obedience State Titles

AWARDS**THE GARRY SOMERVILLE TROPHY**

The winning dog/bitch must compete at all 3 trials on Saturday 30 September, Sunday 1 & Monday 2 October 2017. The winner will have the highest aggregate score in heeling in the Open Class over the weekend with a dog/bitch with a qualifying score in the trial having precedence over non-qualifying scores. In the event of tied scores the winner is to be decided by a heeling "run-off".

THE JACK LOTZKES AWARD

For highest total aggregate scoring UD dog/bitch who must qualify on Saturday 30 September, Sunday 1 & Monday 2 October 2017. Should there be no dog/bitch gain 3 qualifying scores then a dog/bitch will require 2 Open and 2 Utility qualifying scores to be eligible. If the conditions in the first two instances cannot be met to determine a winner, then a dog/bitch will require 3 qualifying scores in the Open Class of 185 points or more.

STATE TITLES MEDALLIONS

For Novice, Open, Utility & Utility Dog Excellent - To be eligible must enter all three trials held on Saturday 30 September, Sunday 1 & Monday 2 October 2017. The qualifying scores from either trial held on the 30 September or 1 October plus the qualifying score from the NSW Obedience State Titles on Monday 2nd October will be counted.

COMMUNITY COMPANION DOG AWARDS

1st, 2nd & 3rd will be awarded on the total qualifying aggregate score from either trial held on Saturday 30th September or Sunday 1st plus the qualifying score from the State Titles on Monday 2nd October 2017.

TRIPLE QUALIFIER MEDALLIONS

For competitors who qualify with the same dog in the same class at the Eastern Suburbs Dog Training Club Trial held 30th September, the Penrith Kennel & Obedience Club Trial held 1st October and the State Titles Trial held 2nd October 2017.
